Indiana Eye Clinic

Nicholas R. Rader, M.D., and Charles O. McCormick III, M.D., co-founded the Indiana Eye Clinic in 1979. The practice originated in the Johnson Memorial Professional Building in Franklin but was later relocated to the Greenwood area. Many patients who first saw Dr. Rader and Dr. McCormick when they opened their practice in August of '79 continue to be patients to this day.

The Emerson Avenue location in Greenwood was developed in 1986 and was the third ophthalmic surgery center to open in Indiana. It is the south side's premier eye care facility offering state-of-the-art medical and surgical care for the eyes. They opened a second clinic in 1993 to serve patients on the west side. William F. Keeling, Ph.D., M.D., joined the practice in 1997 and Carissa M. Barina, M.D., in 2006. David F. Box, M.D., merged his practice with the Indiana Eye Clinic in July 2009. The clinic also has remote offices in Greencastle and Brazil, IN.

Each ophthalmologist is board certified and highly respected in the medical community! Completing the skilled physician team are Thomas M. Funk, O.D., Ronald J. Brinegar, O.D., and Keely D. Allen, O.D. The staff includes nurses, ophthalmic and surgical technicians, opticians, and administrative personnel.

The Indiana Eye Clinic provides complete ophthalmic care including cataract, refractive, laser, lid and other eye surgeries,

comprehensive eye exams for all ages, and the latest technology for testing and treatment of glaucoma, diabetic eye disease, macular degeneration and other health related vision problems. All locations provide high level patient care and up-to-date treatment options.

Our Ambulatory Surgery Center, located at the Indiana Eye Clinic in Greenwood, is Medicare certified and licensed by the Indiana State Department of Health.
